HealthPartners has teamed up with Unite Us to provide community assistance resources to members and patients. Unite Us can help individuals find local assistance and information on social services in their area.

## What types of resources are available on Unite Us?

- **Housing** Income-based housing assistance, eviction and foreclosure prevention, warming and cooling assistance, tenants' rights education, shelters, transitional housing, and more
- Food and nutrition Pantry locations, WIC and SNAP assistance, free meals, meal delivery, community gardening, cooking and healthy eating classes, and nutrition counseling
- **Employment** Career counseling, job search assistance, job training, volunteer opportunities and youth employment details
- Child care and parenting After-school programs, camp and summer programs, parenting skills classes and support, developmental screenings, car seat safety checks, and youth mentoring
- **Transportation** Free or low-cost transportation, bike and car repair, subsidized vehicles, and driver education programs
- Education GED classes and testing, local preschools, tutoring, continuing education, CPR and first-aid training, and school search assistance

You can also find resources to help with financial stability, legal needs, personal safety, immigrant support, exercise and recreation, and more.

#### How it works

It's easy (and free) to find community services and organizations near you:

- Start by typing in your location it can be an address, city or zip code. Then choose how you want to search: either by category or condition.
- 2. Use filters to narrow down your search according to age, distance and more. After you're done, select the "Next" button.
- You'll see a list of services and organizations for what you need, including contact information for each listing. For more information, just select the organization's link.
